Furthermore, Grupo Nutresa strives to find adequate environments for the animals throughout their development process, making sure to achieve productivity always based on sustainability criteria.

Therefore, the Organization is committed to animal well-being by means of the following endeavors:

- Assuring that, by 2027, 100% of its own production of pregnant sows will be discomfort-free, cage-free and will have an appropriate environment for their normal behavior with enough room and adequate facilities.
- Preventing conditions that cause hunger, thirst and diseases to the pigs used in its processes, and mitigating the impact during their pregnancy, feeding, vaccination, transportation and sacrifice.
- In the case of our international meat suppliers, we prioritize those who already have statements regarding good animal well-being practices.
- Ensuring a 100% free-range egg sourcing by 2027. We will work with our poultry chain suppliers so that they develop this animal well-being practice, ensuring the availability of their products at competitive prices and preventing all adverse impacts on our consumers.

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
